

Seasonal Gardener vacancy Winton Castle and Estate

The main purpose of this seasonal role is to support the gardening team in maintaining the gardens and grounds. The successful candidate must have practical horticultural experience and a keen interest in caring for plants. Proficiency in using machinery and hand power tools is desirable, as well as a sound knowledge of plants and plant identification. Additionally, communication skills and a health and safety awareness are required for the role.

Winton Castle is an established, award-winning venue for hospitality as well as a family home so there is aspiration and support for the gardens and grounds to play a significant and memorable part in the offering to visitors. There are 16 acres around Winton Castle with rich variety and plenty going on.

The setting

- "Intimacy on a grand scale" works as a strapline for the castle; it should also reflect the gardens. There is scale, which allows for a surprising range of growing conditions and a unique micro-climate. Garden walls and tree planting contribute to the gardens being able to accommodate tender perennials, climbers & wall shrubs.
- Beautiful, historic landscape with woodland gardens, a loch, a wild garden and flower meadow; south facing terraces with a rose garden, dahlia borders and mixed herbaceous and shrub borders.
- Walled garden (2.5 acres) with extensive mixed borders and wisteria pergola, linked closely with the adjoining Potting Shed venue such that it is well used and much admired.
- Gardens for three farmhouse-style self-catering properties.

Facilities

- Large polytunnel & glasshouse for growing and propagation.
- Comprehensive and well-equipped set of machinery and small tools.

Duties

- To support the garden team with tasks including: weeding, watering, lawn mowing, strimming, transplanting, pruning, deadheading, hedge cutting.
- Ensure gardens, glasshouse and grounds are presentable.
- Machinery safety checks before and after use and other duties in accordance with health and safety policies.

Skills and experience

- Enthusiasm and willingness to get on with the job in all weathers.
- Practical gardening experience.
- Experience in a similar outdoor, physical role.
- Attention to detail and an ability to make full use of tools and machinery.
- Working as part of a team and taking instructions.
- Initiative to plan and prioritise tasks.
- Health & Safety awareness.

Certification

- RHS Level 2 or equivalent would be helpful but not essential.
- Driving license valid for driving within the UK is desirable but not essential.
